

# LOGISTICS AND ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

#### CHECK-IN AND SET UP

- Breweries must check in for a packet and instructions before entering
- Gate C on the north end of Beaver Stadium for load-in and setup
- Breweries will also be able to set up on Friday (5/10/2024)
- Stadium opens at 9 a.m. for setup. VIPs enter at 12 p.m., with setup completion by 11:30 a.m.
- Alcohol exhibitors will have a mandatory meeting at 11:30 a.m.
- The event ends at 5 p.m. All belongings must be removed, leaving a clean space

## REQUIRED PAPERWORK

- Certificate of Insurance (COI) due by Wednesday, May 1, at 5:00 p.m.
- W-9 Form
- Submission of RAMP certifications (or equivalent certifications for breweries outside of Pennsylvania) for all serving staff
- Submission of the official application form

## **WEATHER**

Beaver Stadium is open; be prepared for rain or shine.

# SAFETY GUIDE

**ADMISSION** includes a sample vessel for attendees. Patrons must be 21 with wristbands.

#### **RESPONSIBLE CONSUMPTION**

- One sample per presentation.
- Serve ONLY to designated Hoppy Valley Brewers Fest sampling vessels.
- Sample sizes should not exceed 3-ounce pours.
- Designated drivers cannot sample alcoholic beverages.

As a responsible purveyor, ensure intoxicated patrons are not served. All personnel will be monitoring the crowd to ensure

a safe and positive environment.

#### **HELPFUL RESOURCES**

Free water stations for hydration breaks.

#### WHAT WE PROVIDE

- 10'x10' exhibit space
- Sampling vessels
- Refrigeration storage

### WHAT YOU SHOULD BRING

SERVING STAFF: Each booth, max 4 staff. Contact us with concerns.

BEER: Beers selected for service in 1/6 kegs, with 3-ounce pours. The maximum number of 1/6 kegs permitted is currently TBD. Please serve responsibly. (Chairs optional) PROMOTIONAL ITEMS: Bring stickers, magnets, merchandise (if applicable). No glass items permitted whatsoever.

BOOTH SET UP: Tent, chairs, tables, serving supplies, and promotional items. Water keg for rinsing sample vessels. Stake a minimum of 10 pounds to support each leg (40 pounds total) of your exhibition tent, as per Penn State policy. It is advisable to bring additional weight to err on the side of caution.

## WHAT YOU SHOULD NOT BRING

PROMOTIONAL DRINKING VESSELS **BOTTLED BEVERAGES:** Draft and canned beer only to minimize waste.
